Summary

The Total Affordable Dwellings Completions present information on the amount of total completions of additional affordable dwellings provided by each Local Authority in England annually since 1991.

Technical description

The Total Affordable Dwellings Completions is an estimate, calculated by the Ministry of Housing, Communities and Local Government, of the total amount of affordable dwelling that are added each year per Local Authority (LA). The information is presented either as starts-on-site or completions; for this indicator, only completions were considered. The Total Affordable Dwellings is the sum of Social rent, Affordable rent, Intermediate rent (including London Living rent), Affordable home ownership, Shared ownership and London Affordable rent dwellings. Completions here includes new build, acquisitions and homes where the cost is met by a private developer. In some years, some figures could not be broken down below national level, so the sum of the local authority figures may not equal the total for England figure. Note that not all types of additional affordable dwellings were present since 1991, and some types were introduced later. Values are presented on the basis of financial years, i.e. from April 1st to March 31st. Total Affordable Dwellings figures were calculated for both Lower Tier Local Authorities (HS_14_01L) and Upper Tier Local Authorities (HS_14_01U). Figures from historic LA geography have been referenced to the 2018 LA geography. This includes changes in name/codes, merges, or splits of old LAs to new LAs.

Local Authority Affordable Housing Supply is published by the Ministry of Housing, Communities and Local Government Affordable Housing Statistics. The collection of datasets providing information about the additional supply of affordable dwellings is included in the

Construction of LA-level data

Source data provide values for both Upper Tier and Lower Tier Local Authorities. Essentially, Lower Tier LAs include Shire Districts and Upper Tier LAs Shire Counties. Indicators for both tiers were compiled accordingly (326 and 152 LAs respectively as of 2018). Figures from historic LA geography have been referenced to the 2018 LA geography. This includes changes in name/codes, merges, or splits of old LAs to new LAs. For instance, after 2009 the (upper tier) Cheshire County Council and the (lower tier) 6 Cheshire Local Authority Districts were abolished and replaced by two new Unitary Authorities, Cheshire East and Cheshire West and Chester. In order to calculate the "would-be" Cheshire East's housing figures in 2008, values for the 3 of the 6 historic districts that formed Cheshire East were aggregated.
