Summary

This indicator measures the percentage of patients aged 18 years or over with a diagnosis of chronic kidney disease. Numbers are given for 11 consecutive years, across areas of England.

Technical description

The percentage of patients aged 18 years or over with a diagnosis of chronic kidney disease with classification categories G3a to G5 (previously US National Kidney Foundation stage 3 to 5). The denominator used to calculate the prevalence may include patients below the age of 18. GP practices reporting >30% chronic kidney disease prevalence are excluded from the calculation. QOF data by GP practice and year were provided by the data owners. These data were used to calculate weighted averages of the indicator by Lower Super Output Area (LSOA).

Construction

Data sources

The QOF is a voluntary reward and incentive programme within the General Medical Services contract. It aims to reward GP practices in England for the quality of care they provide to their patients, and to help standardise improvements in the delivery of primary care. Construction of LSOA-level data

The percentage of patients aged 18 years or over with a diagnosis of chronic kidney disease was calculated for each GP practice and year where data were available (the denominator used to calculate the prevalence may include patients below the age of 18). Weighted averages of the indicator per LSOA and year were calculated using annual data provided by NHS Digital on the total number of patients registered per GP practice per LSOA.
